the same being a portion of the property of the Stone Land Company, in the City of Greenville, and being known as Lot No. 8, Section (74) on the West side of Vannoy Street, according to Plat now recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at pages 337 and 345, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Commencing at a stake on the West side of Vannoy Street, joint corners of Lots Nos. 6 and 8, and running thence N. 71-50 W. 192 feet, 7 inches to a stake; thence S. 20-19 W. 55 feet to a stake, joint corners of Lots Nos. 7, 8, 9 and 10; thence S. 71-50 E. 192 feet, 7 inches to a stake on Vannoy Street; thence with said Vannoy Street N. 20-19 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same conveyed to me and Aaron Knigoff by E.
