so long as they may desire, either for the removal of said timber or for any other purpose.

The kind and size of the timber embraced in this conveyance are as follows: The parties of the second part shall have the right to cut all timber, of every kind and nature, which stands eight inches in diameter, eight inches above the ground, in the boundary above

It is understood and agreed by the said parties of the first part that the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, shall have the right to begin autting and removing the said timber at once, and shall have until December 31, 1936, in which to cut and remove all timber described in the boundary herein conveyed.
