- 5. That your petitioner is now advised that National Bondholders Corporation has approved the sale of said property to a certain purchaser, and that said purchaser refuses to accept title to said real property from National Bondholders Corporation without a specific order of this court, confirming and ratifying the deed herein executed by George B. Compton, as Trustee of Interstate Mortgage Company, Debtor, to National Bondholders Corporation.
- 6. That your petitioner, therefore, believes that an order should be made herein approving, ratifying and confirming the deed heretofore executed by George B. Compton to National Bondholders Corporation as hereinabove set Sut.

No previous application has been made to this or any other Court for the relief sought herein.

Wherefore, your petitioner respectfully prays that an order be made granting the relief herein requested.
