F. R. Ellenburg, his heirs and assigns:-
That certain lot of land in or near the town of Gove, Chick
Spring Township, said County and State, designated as Lot
#2 on a plat of the M. S. Gaines estate by W. S. Brockman,
April 21st, 1736; and fronting on South Main Street of
said Town on the East, and measuring thereon sixty (60)
feet; bounded North by Lot #1 on said plat; on the West
by Lots nos. 1 and 5 on said plat, and on the South by lot
#3 thereon, Beginning at iron pin at corner of the
Gaines Home Place, on western edge of said S. Main Street;
and running thence S. 87-05' N. 22-07' feet to iron pin;
thence S. 14-15' C. 61-85' ft. to corner of lot #3 on bound-
ary line of #5; thence N. 89-00' E. 212' feet to point on
edge of S. Main Street, thence along curb with S. Main
