Richard A. Smith, his heirs and assigns:
All of that tract of land situate, lying and
being in the State and County aforesaid, on the
west side of Beaver Dam Creek near Marietta,
and containing 22 acres, more or less, and more
particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stone in the Pumpkintown Road;
thence S. 4 1/2 W. 19.35 to stone by wild cherry; thence
due west 9.59 to stone; thence N. 24.50 to stone;
thence S. 68 1/2 E. 9.00 to bend in said road; thence
S. 56 1/2 E. 3.45 to the beginning corner, less, however,
2 1/2 acres, more or less, conveyed to Lettie E. Galley
by deed recorded Deed Book 133, page 234, and
described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in what is known
as the Pumpkintown road and runs thence N. 64 1/2
W. 3.45 along the old road to another pin; thence
along the old road N. 66 1/2 W. 9.23 to an iron
pin; thence S. 2 W. 2.15 to an iron pin; thence
S. 84 1/2 E. 2.77 to bend in the present Pumpkin-
town Road; thence further along said road S. 73
E. 4.77 to bend; thence S. 86 1/2 E. 4.70 to beginning
corner.

"The present Pumpkintown Road" is the road
that was in use at the time the Galley deed, above
referred to, was executed.
