KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Charlton C. Gaines, Olin A. Gaines, Jr., and Margaret G. Childs,

in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
one dollar each, and the execution of the  
trusts herein after stated, DOLLARS

to us  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Olin A. Gaines

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Olin A. Gaines, as Trustee for Charlton C. Gaines, Olin A. Gaines, Jr. and Margaret G. Childs, his successors, heirs and assigns, the following real property on the south side of the Southern Railway, in or near the Town of Greer, Hick Springs Township, said County and State:

Beginning at the intersection of the said railway and South Main Street of said Town of Greer, and running thence with the railroad 12 chains and 42 links to a stake on or near said railroad; thence S. 15° E. 5.71 to a stone 34; thence N. 75° E. 10.00 to a stake in said S. Main Street, near Post Oak; thence with said road 6.72 to the beginning, as described and conveyed to Noah Cannon by H. B. Cunningham in deed recorded in Book L at page 124, but more particularly described by plat thereof made by H. S. Brockman, May 17th, 1936, of the M. J. Gaines Estate, containing six and one-half acres, more or less. Plat D/156

Also, that other parcel or lot of land in or near the said Town of Greer, said Township, County and State, containing three and three-tenths acres, more or less.

Beginning at a point on the northerndge of Cannon Avenue of said Town, 150 feet from intersection of South Main Street and said Cannon Avenue, and running thence with Cannon Avenue N. 82-15 W. 42 8 ft. to corner Gaines Avenue and Cannon Avenue; thence (crossing and skipping 30 feet for Gaines Avenue) N. 82-15 W. 70 feet to corner; thence still along Cannon Avenue, skipping and eliminating 100 feet for lot sold, same course for a distance of 261 feet to iron pin, corner of P. R. Smith Estate on Cannon Avenue; thence N. 18-45 E. 196 feet to point; then N. 1-50 W. 127 feet to iron pin; thence S. 75-15 W. 125 feet to iron pin; thence S. 71-45 W. 180.5 feet to iron pin; thence skipping 100 feet for sold lot, S. 87-45 W. 70 feet to edge of Gaines Avenue, thence, skipping 30 feet for Gaines Avenue, S. 87-45 W. 451 feet to point; thence S. 87-0 W. 95.3 feet to the beginning point; bounded south by Cannon Avenue; East by Estate of P. R. Smith; North by other property formerly of the Estate of M. J. Gaines and West by lot formerly of the said M. J. Gaines Estate. Plat D/260

The last above described lot is more particularly shown by a plat of M. J. Gaines property prepared by H. A. Christopher, June 14th, 1923, and all of the above property having been devised to the said M. J. Gaines by the Will of Noah Cannon.

This conveyance is made to the grantees as Trustee of the grantors, in Trust, to hold, manage, sell, or exchange or hypothecate, or in any wise dispose of the said property or any part of parts thereof, from time to time, and to accept payment in mortgage or other forms and to mortgage, exchange or in any wise pledge the same, in any part, as security, and to execute

and deliver and accept any and all forms of writings, notes and paper, for the sale and delivery of said property, for the use and benefit of said grantee, H. A. Christopher, and without necessary threat, and shall conveyance, conveying all my right, title, interest, and claim in and to the said property, in accordance with the law of the said State of South Carolina, and to the said M. J. Gaines, deceased.
