Township, County and State aforesaid, on branch of Marsh
Creek, waters of South Tyger River, and having the following

thence N. 57 W. 136 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to iron pin on East bank of road; thence
N. 25-15 E. 148 feet to center of Ridge Road; thence S. 63-30 W. 175
feet to angle in center of Ridge Road; thence N. 68-30 W. 200 feet
