(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John M. Lynch:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville
State of South Carolina, near the Woodside Cotton Mill,
in a sub-division known as "Donwood" and being
designated as lot number fifty-five (55) on a plat by
said subdivision made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer,
which plat is recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book "A" at page 462 463. Said lot has a
frontage on Linda Street of fifty feet and runs back
in depth of one hundred fifty feet, and has such
courses and distances as are shown on said plat.

Subject to the following conditions, to-wit:

Reserving to the said grantor, Ora Locke and her
husband, J. P. M. Locke during their natural lives a life
estate in said premises, conditioned upon the said
John M. Lynch paying the monthly payments to the
Home Owners Loan Corporation of the sum of eight
Dollars and three cents on the principal sum of
One Thousand Fifteen Dollars as is shown by the
record of said mortgage dated May 23rd 1935 and
recorded in the R. M. C. Office on the 25th day of May
1935, recorded in book Vol 1254 at page 70. The said
Locke to occupy two rooms in the house on said
premises during the term of their natural lives and
the said John M. Lynch agrees to pay all taxes,
and the water and light bills as same are
due and become due.
