Theodora Elizabeth Adams,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

in hand paid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John E. Gardner, his Heirs and Assigns forever:
that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina,
County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, about 2 1/2 miles
from the City of Greenville, and being a portion of lot
No. 1, of the property of D. Townsend Smith, as shown by
plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book F, at page 108, and having the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of
Mount Vista Avenue, corner of lot of Mr. Theodora Elizabeth
Adams, and running thence with said Mount Vista
Avenue, S. 64-20 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on Mount Vista
Avenue, corner of lot of W. L. Valentine; thence along line
of Valentine lot, N. 25-40 W. 260 feet to an iron pin in line
of Valentine lot and lot of Theodora Elizabeth Adams;
thence N. 64-20 E. 100 feet to an iron pin in line of other
lot of Theodora Elizabeth Adams; thence along the line of
said lot S. 25-40 E. 260 feet to the beginning corner, being
all of the lot conveyed to George Alexander Adams by
D. Townsend Smith by deed dated April 2, 1927, and
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in
Vol. 145, page 383, and being the rear portion of the
lot conveyed to Theodora Elizabeth Adams by Mrs.
M. T. Smith Nov. 21, 1930 by deed recorded in the R. M. C.
Office for Greenville County in Vol. 187, page 227, upon
which there is located a combination storehouse
and garage, said lot being 100 feet wide by 60 feet deep.

the lot adjoining the above described property without
any charges to said purchaser. The lot referred to
is in the name Theodora Elizabeth Adams and
is situate on the East side of the lot this purchased by John E. Gardner.)
