H. M. McJunkin:

All those two certain piece, parcels or tracts of land lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on Paris Mountain Road and on Mountain Creek, one tract being that bought of Mrs. Mattie Jenkins on October 3, 1932 and having the following meter and bounds to-wit, as per survey made by H. A. Ellis, Surveyor, on October 1st, 1932: Beginning on bridge over Mountain Creek on the Paris Mountain Road over middle of Creek; thence due South 9.50 to iron pin in road; thence N. 38 E. 9.90 to stone corner 0m; thence N. 40 W. 4.35 to Mountain Creek; thence up said Creek to the beginning corner and containing 3.68 Acres, more or less.

Also all that other certain tract of land lying adjacent to the above described tract and being a portion of a tract of land conveyed by Ida Hesterly to me, said deed recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., in book 1157 at page 166, and having the following meter and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at stone 0m corner of above described tract, thence N. 40 W. 4.35 to mountain creek; thence with said Creek as line to McHarter's line; thence S. 36 W. about 10.75 to the beginning corner, and containing 2.25 acres, more or less, and the two tracts containing in the aggregate 5.93 Acres, more or less.
