(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Paul G. Cushman, all that certain piece or parcel of land just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville on the east side of Rutherford Street and described as follows:-

Beginning two hundred and thirty-three (233) feet north of the northeast corner of Rutherford and Randall Streets, and running thence with Rutherford Street S. 1-41 W. seven (7) feet to a pin, being the northwest corner of Cushman lot; thence with Cushman line S. 85-39 E. two hundred (200) feet to a pin, rear line of lots 3 and 4; thence North 82-35 West two hundred (200) feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, and being the northern portion of Lot No. 3 of Section "A" of a plat of Stone Land Company recorded in Plat Book "A" pp 337 to 345, and being part of one of the lots conveyed to me by Stone Land Company by deed dated June 25, 1909, deed recorded in R.
