A. Hester, December 17, 1935:

Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of this lot and other land of Hettie Rogers, thence running S. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2 chains to an iron pin, thence N. 54 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 75 links to an iron pin, thence N. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2 chains to a pin, across a road north of said road, to an iron pin, thence S. 54 E. 75 links to the beginning corner, being a part of the land described in the deed from J. B. Davis, et al, to Hettie Rogers, recorded in Deed Book 161, page 64, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County; said lot contains according to said survey one eighth of an acre.
