Resignation of Trustee

Whereas, by a certain deed of trust, dated May 1, 1930 and recorded on the 14th day of May, 1930 in Book 193, Page 205, of the records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Lewis Barber unmarried conveyed to South Carolina National Bank, Greenville, South Carolina and Union Trust Company of Maryland, a Corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the state of Maryland and having its principal place of business in the City of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, as Trustees, the property therein described, to secure the indebtedness therein mentioned, to which trust deed reference is here made; and

Whereas, the undersigned, Union Trust Co. Maryland, is unwilling to act as such trustee and desires to be relieved of the duty of executing said trust

Now, therefore, this instrument witnesseth; that the undersigned Union Trust Company of Maryland, a corporation, does hereby decline and refuse to act as the trustee designated in said deed of trust and does hereby resign as such trustee.
