Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina One + no/100 Dollars, in consideration of which I hereby grant and convey unto said Company its associated and allied companies, their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, a perpetual right of way and easement to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain lines of telegraph and telephone, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, across, over and/or under the property which I own or in which I have any interest in the vicinity of Taylors, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and upon, along and/or under the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, with the right to trim from time to time any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and cables cleared at least thirty-six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company and with the further right to cut down and to keep cut down all trees, limbs of trees and undergrowth within 25 feet of said line, same sum being received in full payment for the rights herein granted.
