Ware Estate, according to the plat recorded in Plat Book C, at page 264, P.M.C. Office for said Greenville County said lots together having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning on Plett street, corner of lots nos. 7 and 8, and running thence with joint line of lots nos. 7 and 8 N. 18° 45' W. 125 feet, thence on line common to lots nos. 7 and 8 N. 71° 15' E. 114 feet to corner of lot nos. 5; thence running with line of lot no. 5 and continuing N. 18° 16' W. 75 feet to corner of lot no. 3; thence with line of lots nos. 3 and 4, S. 71° 15' W. 101.9 feet to Pine street, thence with Ware street and Perry Avenue and Plett Street, 262.3 feet to the beginning corner.
