Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

The following described tract of land lying in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Saluda Township, on both sides of the East fork of Fall Creek adjoining lands of J. W. Hightower, Anderson Gordon and Alfred Ward, Estate.

Begins on a white oak and running S. 3 E. 3.45 to a stake; thence E. 3.00 to a stake in the creek; thence S. 12.00 to a dogwood on top of a ridge J. W. Hightower corner; thence with his line S. 67 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 19.00 to a dogwood his corner; thence with said Hightower line line N. 57 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 26.25 to a chestnut; thence N. 72 E. 3.75 to a rock in Hightower's line; thence N. 76 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 27.50 with Anderson Gordon's line to a stake in the Saluda Road near a persimmon; thence with said road N. 29 E. 6.00 to a stake in the road; thence N. 61 E. 5.00 to a stake in the road; thence N. 40 E. 3.75 to an apple tree near the Philips Branch; thence N. 58 E. 2.50 to a stake at the mouth of a hollow; thence up with said hollow N. 31 E. 1.75 to a stake in the hollow; thence N. 57 E. 2.00 to stake in the hollow; thence N. 6 E. 2.00 to a stake in hollow; thence N. 35 E. 1.50 to a stake in hollow; thence N. 37 E. 1.50 to a stake in hollow; thence N. 15 E. 4.75 to a chestnut at head of the hollow; thence N. 30 W. 3.75 to a poplar in the head of hollow; thence down the hollow S. 72 W. 1.50 to stake in the hollow; thence S. 53 W. 5.50 to stake in hollow; thence S. 85 W. 3.00 to a stake at the road; thence N. 45 W. 2.50; thence S. 66 W. 2.50 to the head of a ditch; thence with ditch S. 88 W. 3.50 to creek; thence N. 84 W. to a locust stump thence N. 77 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 7.50 to Nickony; thence S. 62 W. 4.00 to a sprig; S. 18 W. 8.00 to a small poplar; thence S. 5 W. 6.50 to a stake; thence S. 60 W. 1.00 to chestnut; thence S. 13 - to the beginning corner.
