all that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Greenville* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

situate on the north side of Chaugh Avenue, and beginning at an iron pin at the corner of lot owned by W. L. Rogers and running thence with his line in a northeasterly direction 140 feet to a stake; thence in a north-westerly direction parallel with Chaugh Avenue 75 feet to a stake; thence in a southwesterly direction in a line parallel to the first described line 140 feet to a stake on Chaugh Avenue; thence with Chaugh Avenue S. 55° E. 75 feet to the beginning corner embracing all of the southern portion of Lot No. 120 and one half of the eastern portion of Lot No. 121, as shown on a plat made by W.
