In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release,

unto the said May B. King,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

commencing at a stake in center of C. & L. Division of Southern Railway, at corner of J. E. Richey property; thence along line of Richey property crossing the P. & N. Railroad N. 188-0 W. 591 feet to an iron pipe on the East right-of-way line of Concrete road, State Highway No. 20, thence along the East side of right-of-way of said road S. 14-30 W. 261 feet to a bend; thence continuing with said right-of-way line S. 6-20 W. 284.7 feet to an iron pipe, corner of property of L. S. Pacific; thence along line of L. S. Pacific S. 88-0 E. 557 feet to a point via C. & L. Division of Southern Railway; thence along center of said Railroad N. 6-27 E. 66 feet to a stake; thence N. 11-57 E. 125.0 feet to a stake, in center of Railroad; thence N. 17-02 E. 241.8 feet to the stake at the beginning point.
