All that certain lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in that section known as Sans Souci, on Rogers Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern edge of the six foot sidewalk along Rogers Avenue, the same being the joint corner of lots three (3) and (4), and running thence along said sidewalk, N. 83-55 E. fifty (50) feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots four and five (4 and 5); thence N. 5-50 W. one hundred and fifty (150) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 83-55 W. fifty (50) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 5-50 E. one hundred and fifty (150) feet to an iron pin on the northern edge of the sidewalk along Rogers Avenue, the beginning corner, the same lot being known and designated as Lot numbered four (4) on plat of said property recorded in the R.
