the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Winnie Chambers, all that lot, tract or parcel of land lying on northeast side of McKee Road and about 15 feet from it, being in Chick Spring Township, County and State aforesaid, adjoining the McKee lands on the west, a lot bargained by J. P. Griffin to Willie Cunningham on the north and a lot sold to W. J. Edwards on the south, and having the following meter and bounds:

Beginning on iron pin in old abandoned road, about 15 feet from McKee Road, thence N. 48 3/4 E. 3.16 chains to J. P. on line of other lands of the grantor, thence S. 42 3/4 E. .79 of a chain to iron pin in said old road, thence N. 42 3/4 W. .79 of a chain to the beginning corner, and containing one fourth of an acre, more or less, according to survey made by J. Earle Freeman Mar 2, 1937.
