All that piece, parcel or lot of land on the north side of Easley Bridge Road, near the Odd Fellows Orphanage, known as part of lot No. 49 and all of lot No. 50 as shown on plat of property of J. R. Young, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, and recorded in R. M. C. O. T. for said County in Plat Book N, page 51, and having the following corner and distance according to said plat:

Beginning at a stake, corner of Orphanage property, and running thence with line of Orphanage property N. 12 W. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to stake in line of Camilla R. Cooper; thence with her line N. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ S. E. 99.8 feet, more or less, to stake, corner of lot heretofore cornered by A. L. C. Oxner to N. 8.
