All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and being known and designated as plat of property of Colonia Company, made by Dalton & Hene Engineers, Greenville, 1928, and recorded in Plat Book "E" at Page 102, as lots 95 and 95 A. and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Donnybrook Street, said pin being 245 ft. from the intersection of Donnybrook St. and Brunswick Rd. said pin being at the joint corner of Lots #94 and #95 and running thence along the common line of lots #94 and #95 and #94 A. and #95 A. N. 58-05-W. 216 ft. to an iron pin on the line of W. N. Miller; thence with the Miller line N. 42-50 E. 60.75 ft. to the corner of Lot #98; thence with the rear line of Lots #96, #97 and #98 S. 58-05-E. 202.2 ft. to an iron pin on the West side of Donnybrook St. near corner of Lot #96; thence with the West side of Donnybrook St. S. 38-50 W. 60 ft. to the point of beginning.
