I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *Clara Townsend, individually and as Administratrix of the Estate of Evelyn S. Mitchell, deceased, and N. J. Sanford, as Administrator c. t. a. of the Estate of William S. Mitchell, deceased.*

on or about the *12th* day of *December* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty-six* exhibited *their* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against *Arthur Townsend et al*

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *Six hundred fifteen (\$ 615.00)* Dollars, to me paid by the said *R. P. Turner*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *R. P. Turner*

All that lot of land on the north side of Arlington Avenue, in the Town of Greer, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot No. 6 on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", Page 279, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north side of Arlington Avenue, corner of Lot No. 1, 175 feet East from Broad Street street, a Mostella street, and running thence with the lines of Lots Nos. 1, 2 and 3, in a northerly direction 175 feet to corner of Lot No. 8; thence with the line of Lot No. 8 in an Easterly direction 64 feet to corner of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of Lot No. 7 in a southerly direction 175 feet to Arlington Avenue; thence with the northern side of Arlington Avenue in a West-erly direction 64 feet to the beginning corner; being the same lot conveyed to W.
