NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seventy-five (\$75.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said C. P. Phillips,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. P. Phillips,

"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as tract No. 6, of the Warren Walber property, as shown on a subdivision and plat of same, made by W. J. Middle, August 3, 1936, containing 2.30 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds and course and distances, as shown by said plat to wit: Beginning at a stake in the center of a road and in line of tract No. 40 W. 183 feet to a stake in center of said road; thence along the center of said road and in the line of tract No. 5 N. 50 W. 398 feet to a stake in line of land of Chas.
