the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Home Owners' Loan Corporation

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, or to be erected thereon, situate, lying and being on the western side of North Main Street, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, known as No. 711 North Main Street; being the lot shown on plat of property of W. T. Jordan made by A. S. Bedell, engineer, August 30, 1914, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "O" at page 177; being bounded on the North by lot now or formerly owned by J. J. McSwain, on the East by North Main Street, on the South by lot now or formerly owned by Annie L. Jordan and on the West by lot now or formerly owned by J. J.
