the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the
said William Burton

"all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying
and being in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, South
Carolina, about five miles Northwest of the town of
Green, beginning at an iron pin in line of lot number
one and running thence S. 50 1/4 W. 842 feet to a
stone; thence S. 29 7/8 E. 276 feet to a stone; thence N.
52 1/2 E. 1250 feet to a stone; thence S. 78 1/2 W. 398 feet
to an iron pin; thence N. 43 1/4 W. 119 feet to the beginning
