demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 1937, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master In and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said J. E. Sonnell and M. H. Lynn

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. E. Sonnell and M. H. Lynn

"All that certain lot of land in Greenville County, Greenville Township, South Carolina, on the east side of Earley Bridge Road, about two and one-half (2 1/2) miles from Greenville Court House, S.C., and beginning on Piedmont Avenue, corner of lot No. 4, and running thence with the line of lot No. 4, N. 80-30 E. 150 feet; thence N. 9-30 W. 88 feet to Earley Bridge Road; thence with Earley Bridge Road S. 70 W. 151 feet to Piedmont Avenue; thence with Piedmont Avenue, S. 9-30 E. 60 feet to beginning corner, being lot No. 2 of Edgemont, a subdivision of land represented by a plat recorded in Plat Book D, page 35, R.M.C.
