and State of South Carolina, containing 22 acres, more
or less, and bounded by the lands of U. A. Berry, F. E.
Niles and others being the same tract of land conveyed
to W. G. Childress by Annie Childress, J. W. Childress, and
S. E. Childress by deed bearing date August 19, 1914.
