the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the
said W. F. Campbell

State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Glassy Mountain Township, Beginning
on a stake C. S. West and B. C. Adkins line in old road and runs thence S. 82 1/2 E.
1.84 to a stake; thence N. 30 1/2 E. 36.38 to a stone on D. R. Evans line; thence
N. 24 1/2 W. 32.37 to a stake on Greens Creek; thence up creek about 7 cns. to the
mouth of a small branch; thence up small branch about 11 cns. to a stone; thence S.
