and designated as Tract No. 4 of the Nancy Roberts Place, recorded in Plat Book "A", page 167, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 10 acres more or less, adjoining lands of Person Pike, Mc Gee, et al.

Also, all that other piece, parcel or lot of land in the state and county aforesaid being Lot No 3, of a survey of John S. Ciretor, D. S., October 16, 1906, of the Billie Roberts Tract, situate about 3 miles from the City of Greenville in Greenville County containing 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ 35/100 acres more or less, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stone on the southeast corner of Lot No. 3 at the junction of Lots nos. 2, 3, 7 and 8, running thence N. 22 E. 3.10 chains to a stone; thence N. 57 - 1/8 W. 14.80 chains to a stone; thence N. 61 1/4 W. 6.70 chains to a stone; thence S. 7 1/2 W. 11.50 chains to a stone; thence S. 82 E. 19.10 chains to the beginning corner.
