Beginning at an iron pin on the old Pelham Road corner of lands of Phillips and running thence with Phillips' line, N. 22 1/4 W. 7.44 to an iron pin; thence with line of the property of Ward and Plantation Road, N. 21 3/4 W. 16.50 to a Belch Jack, gone, corner of Bramlett land; thence with his line, S. 85 1/2 W. 10.75 to an iron pin corner of tract conveyed to Gertrude N.
