near the Paris Mountain Road, having a frontage on Laurel Street of 50 feet, and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 on plat of property of S. D. Oxner made by R. E. Dalton, Eng., April, 1923, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on Laurel Street, joint corner of Lots 2 and 3, and running thence along Laurel Street S. 55-54 E. 50 feet to corner of lot No. 4; thence along the line of lot No. 4 S. 33-54 W. 178.2 feet to Bates St.; thence along Bates Street, N. 56-06 W. 50 feet to corner of Lot No. 2; thence along line of lot No. 2, N. 33-54 E. 178.3 feet to the beginning corner.
