School District No 6-A, containing 7.43 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances according to survey made by H. J. Riddle, Surveyor, Feb 19, 1938:

Beginning at a stake 10 feet southwest from stone joint corner of J. T. Shockley and Blackmon and running hence with line of J. T. Blackmon S. 26° 45' W. 861 feet to stake corner of Mt. A. Garrison; thence with Garrison line S. 79° 30' W. 654 feet to stake; thence still with Garrison line N. 3° E. 457 feet to stake, corner of Shockley; thence with Shockley line S. 65° E. 272 feet to stake; thence still with Shockley line N. 54° 30' E. 928 feet to the beginning.
