All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Cleveland Township, on the south side of Southside Drive and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at the corner of the lot now owned by J. E. Irvine and running thence with line of lot deeded to J. E.
