in consideration of the sum of One (100) and Love and affection Dollars,to me paid by Loyd Balding and Clara Baldingin the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Loyd Balding and Clara Balding, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, State and County aforesaid containing three (3) acres, more or less adjoining lands of Kelly Taylor, Nell Dalton and also lands of ourselves and being a part of that certain tract of land conveyed to J. C. Elrod by C. Irwin, Master in and for Greenville County, deed dated March 21, 1829 and recorded in R. M. L. Office for said County in Vol. 149 page 32. And the said J. C. Elrod later conveyed a one-half interest to the aforesaid Anna Elrod. See the public records appertaining thereto. We reserve to ourselves, heirs and assigns a roadway for ingress and egress to our lands and through the lands hereby conveyed."

"It is understood and agreed that the grantee herein reserves a life estate in the property granted."

The above described land is J. C. Elrod and Anna
Elrod on the 11th day of September, 1837, deed recorded in office of Register
 of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 187 Page 147.

 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Loyd Balding and

Clara Balding, their heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Loyd Balding and Clara Balding,
 their and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other

person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
