All the undivided one half interest heretofore owned by the Estate of R. D. Dobson, deceased, of, in and to all that parcel or tract of land about one mile west of the town of Greer, Chick Springs Township, said County and State, and

Beginning at a point in the center of the Smith road 20 feet west of an iron pin, and runs thence with the center of the said road to the center of the National Highway; thence nearly west following the National Highway to its intersection with the public road leading to Gilreath's Mill on the C. L. King line; thence N. 31-28 W. to an iron pin on the W. W. Burgiss line, thence S. 74-11 E. 897 feet to a point at the beginning, and designated as Lots Nos. 52 to 66 inclusive on plat of W. H.
