In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said.....Bertha Gossell Harris, all my right, title and interest, the same being a one-half undivided interest in the all that piece of land or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the city of Greenville, Township and having the following metes and bounds, according to plat made by P. C. Dalton, Engineer:

Beginning at a point on the north side of Webster Street, adjoining other property of the grantor, and running thence North 10° 12' E. 117 feet more or less; thence N. 67° 30' 21.44 feet; thence South 20° 12' West through an outhouse 119 feet to Webster Street; thence with Webster Street south 68° 48' E. 44 feet to the point of beginning.
