in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said Mary Earle Brockman, her heirs and assigns forever all that certain lot of land located near Green in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the West side of Road leading from National Highway to Greer Manufacturing Company, beginning at a point on said road at the corner of the Baxter Hemphill lot, (which is lot No. 1 of the N. S. Brockman property), and running thence with his line S. 45-30 W. 226 feet to a point, thence S. 44-30 E. 70 feet to a point, thence N. 45-30 W. 226 feet to a point on the road mentioned above, and thence with said Road N. 44-30 W. 70 feet to the beginning, being Lot No. 2 of the N. S. Brockman property, conveyed Grantors by E. Inman, Master, duly recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
