The Pentecostal Holiness Church of Greer, S. C., and its now Trustees,
W. C. Blackwell, J. W. Lindsay, Furman Dill and Henry Barton and their successors in office,
its successors and assigns, all that certain lot or parcel of land situated in or near the
Town of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being
more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Pelham Street, at corner of Lot No. 11 of Cannon Park,
and running thence along the said street N. 37.30 E. 54.5 feet to an alley; thence along the
said alley N. 71 W. 216 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 16; thence along the line of
Lot No. 16, S. 24.15 W. 52 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 11; thence along the
line of Lot No. 11, S. 71 E. 206 feet to the beginning corner, being all of Lot No. Ten (10)
of the Cannon Park lands as surveyed by H. G. Bailey, Surveyor, on November 1919. This is the
same lot of land conveyed to C. J. Willis and W. V. Hawkins by deed of E. Inman, Master, dated
September 5th, 1927, and made pursuant to a decree in the cause of C. J. Willis and W. V.
