Tract No. 1: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the North side of Pinckney Street, and fronting on Pinckney Street, known as Lot No. 19 on Plat made by W. A. Hudson, Surveyor, bearing date of July 8, 1908, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", page 265, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Pinckney Street at corner of J. N. Alverson lot, being Lot No. 18 on said Plat, and running thence along Pinckney Street S. 34 E. 62 feet to corner of Raines lot, being Lot No. 20 on said Plat; thence N. 56 E. 175 feet to a stake; thence N. 34 W. 62 feet to corner of said Lot No. 18; thence along the line of Lot No. 18 S. 56 W. 175 feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to me by E. L. Little by his deed dated June 14, 1932, and recorded in Deed Book 160, page 264, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

Tract No. 2:- All that lot of land in Ward I of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an established corner at Echols Street, and running thence N. 35 1/2 W. 100 feet to a stake in Grubbs line; thence N. 57 1/2 E. 83 feet to a stake; thence S. 35 1/2 E. 100 feet to a stake; thence S. 57 1/2 W. 83 feet to the point of beginning, being the same conveyed to me by E. L. Little by his deed dated June 14, 1932, and recorded in Deed Book 160; page 264, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

Tract No. 3:- All that piece, parcel and lot of land in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville fronting on the North side of Ann Street, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the North side of Ann Street, which point is 12 1/4 feet West of the Northwest intersection of Glover and Ann Streets, and running thence in a Westerly direction with Ann Street 95 feet to corner of lot now or formerly owned by Henry Campbell; thence in a Northerly direction 105 feet, more or less, to corner of lot now or formerly owned by Carolina Construction Company, thence in an Easterly direction with rear line of lot now or formerly owned by Carolina Construction Company 95 feet, more or less, to point in line of lot now or formerly owned by H.
