Belle R. Hunt

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville near the corner of Buncombe Street and Butler Avenue and being the rear southern portion of Lot No. B according to a plat of F. G. Rogers recorded in Plat Book "C" at page 11, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin corner of lots C and D running thence N. 51 W. 80 feet, more or less to an iron pin in line of lot A; thence with line of lot A, S. 46-15 W. 38 feet to an iron pin corner of lots A and B; thence with line of lot B, S. 36- E. 93.5 feet to corner of lots B and D; thence with line of lot D, N. 34-30 E. 59 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, and being a part of the same lot of land conveyed to J. Lee Green by G. A. Buist and D. B. Anderson as Executors, by deed dated April 9, 1914 and recorded in R. M. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 21 at page 541.

The grantors herein, who are all sui juris, are the sole heris at law of J. Lee Green who died intestate February 2, 1934.
