All real estate and all rights in real property of every kind whatsoever now belonging to Mauldin Ginnery, Inc., including:-

(1) All that lot of land situate in the Town of Mauldin, in the County and State aforesaid, and more particularly described according to a resurvey and plat made by W. J. Riddle, June 28th., 1937, as follows:
