(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Woodrow B. Painter:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the west side of Print Works Street near the village formerly known as Piedmont Print Works, adjoining lands of Will Hammett on the east, lands of Southern Bleachery and Print Works on the south, and other lands of the grantor on the west and north, and having, according to a survey made by J. Earle Freeman, Engineer, February 2, 1937, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in center of Print Works Street at corner of land of Southern Bleachery and Print Works, and running thence with the line of said property N. 81 1/2 W. 190.8 feet to an iron pin at corner of property of grantor and said Southern Bleachery and Print Works; thence with other property of grantor N. 18 1/2 W. 59.3 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 2; thence with the line of Lot No. 2 N. 67 1/2 E. 159.7 feet to a point in center of Print Works Street on line of Will Hammett property; thence with said Hammett line and with the center of Print Works Street S. 22 1/2 E. 157.6 feet to the beginning corner, and containing .44 acres, more or less, and further designated as Lot No. 1 on plat of property of G. D. Collier.
