

EXCHANGE PLANT PERMIT.

(May, 1936)

Received of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, One Dollar in consideration of which I hereby grant, unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of telephone and telegraph, and for the general transmission of intelligence, including the necessary underground and aerial cable, conduit, poles, wires and fixtures with the further right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company or person, to said poles and fixtures upon and over or under the property which I own, or in which I have an interest, located in the block bounded by Bates, Honour, Center and Cobb, Sts. near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, said sum is received in full payment of said rights.

The Company agrees to re-locate at its own expense, on said property, its lines and fixtures to conform with future building improvements.

By this Memorandum between E. R. Keller of the first part and John R. Snelgrove of the second part, it is mutually agreed that the party of the first part shall convey to the party of the second part the following land: House and lot at corner of Curtis and Church St. lot measuring 80 x 180 ft. Simpsonville, S. C. also house and lot at Fair Heights, size of lot 50 x 150 ft.

All taxes and insurance to be operated as of date of transfer. This trade is to be consummated if the party of the first part can arrange to reduce his loan to \$2934.00.

And the party of the second part shall convey to the party of the first part the following land: House and lot at corner of Cox St. & W. McBees Ave, known as Ambler; house, containing seventeen rooms, lot fronting 134.2' on McBees, 144.1' on Cox rear line 90.2' other line 134.2'

All conveyances to be made on or before March 5, 1938 and as a further consideration the party of the first part agrees assume \$2934.00 mortgage on McBees Ave. property; and party of second part agrees to assume \$2934.00 mortgage on Simpsonville house & on Fair Heights house.
