the sum of Two Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$200.00) DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)  
has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto George Stevenson, Louis  
Wallace and J. H. Cheek, as Trustees of Macedonia Baptist Church:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in State and County aforesaid, near  
the City of Greenville, S. C. and being known and designated as Lot No. 10 of Property of  
American Building and Loan Association as shown by plat of same made by R. E. Dalton,  
Engineer, April 23, 1932, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in  
Plat Book H, page 199, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of Young Street, at corner of Property now  
owned by Macedonia Baptist Church, and running S. 12-30 W. 145 feet to a stake; thence S.  
64-14 E. 39.1 feet to stake, joint corner of Lot Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the line of  
Lot No. 9 N. 14-20 E. 152.6 feet to stake on South side of Young Street; thence along Young  
Street N. 75-40 W. 42.9 feet to the point of beginning.
