the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Miss Louise Cox her heirs and assigns forever, one half of lot in Graceland Cemetery, Greenville City, State and County aforesaid, designated as Lot No. 117, Section No. 2, containing one hundred (100) square feet, known as front half of lot. The same being described and designated as above, in accordance with map on file in the office of the Greenville Cemetery Asso. It is distinctly understood that said half lot is to be used exclusively for the burial of human bodies of the white race and sold and conveyed subject to all rules and regulations of said Graceland Cemetery and any additions or amendments for the government of said Graceland Cemetery which may hereafter be adopted.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by H. C. Robinson on the 24 day of July 1936 deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book X Page X

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Miss Louise Cox, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Miss Louise Cox, her heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
