KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Furman University

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Fifty and no/100 (\$2,050.00) DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee (s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Carl P. Thompson;

Those two certain adjoining lots of land situate in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the northwest side of Harris Street, designated as lots Nos. 34 and 35 on plat made by W. D. Neves, Engineer, October 22, 1913, recorded in Plat Book C at page 261, to-wit:-

Lot No. 34 begins at corner of Lot No. 35 on Harris Street and runs thence with Harris Street in an easterly direction 60 feet to corner of Lot No. 33; thence with line of Lot No. 33, 127.8 feet to corner; thence 60 feet to corner of Lot No. 35; thence with line of Lot No. 35, 128.5 feet to beginning corner.

Being the same lot conveyed to Furman University by W. J. Langston by deed dated December 16, 1919, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 57, at page 300.

Lot No. 35 begins at corner of Lot No. 35 on Harris Street; thence in southwesterly direction 60 feet to corner of Lot No. 36 as shown on said plat; thence with line of Lot No. 36 in a northerly direction to corner; thence 60 feet to corner of Lot No. 34; thence with line of Lot No. 34, 128.5 feet to beginning corner on Harris Street.

Being the same lot conveyed to Furman University by R. H. and A. T. Sublett by deed dated April 14, 1920, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 63, at page 594.
