Church,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
J. D. Flemming, A. B. Hood, J. W. Brown, R. L. Wynn, Henry Miller, B. E. Campbell, James Hannah,
Lewis J. Vaughn, and R. B. Finley, Deacons of the Fairview Baptist Church and their successors
in office. All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State
and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, about two and one half miles West of the Town of
Greer, on the West side of the Buncombe Road, adjoining lands of the Fairview Baptist Church
Cemetery and lands of R. B. Vaughn, and being triangular in shape, and having the following
courses and distances, to-wit:-

First plot being conveyed by R. B. Vaughn; Beginning on a stake on the West side of
the Buncombe Road, corner of the cemetery grounds, and runs thence with the road N. 65-23 W. 80
feet to a stake or iron pin on the North corner of the intersection point of the said Buncombe
Road and the drive way around the cemetery; thence with the North side of the said drive way S.
33-51 W. 179.5 feet to an iron pin on the original cemetery line; thence with the cemetery original
line N. 56-10 E. 207.9 feet to the beginning corner.

Second plot being conveyed by Landrum J. Vaughn; Beginning on an iron pin on the
North side of the Gilreath Mill Road and in the center of the driveway around the cemetery and
being an original corner of the cemetery grounds, and runs thence with the center of the said drive
way and the original line of the cemetery grounds and Landrum J. Vaughn, N. 34-50 W. 27-.5 feet
to an iron pin on the said original line; thence S. 33-51 W. 9.7 feet to a stake; thence S.
34-50 E. 269 feet to a stake on the North side of the Gilreath Mill Road; thence with the said road
N. 42-15 E. 9.2 feet to the beginning corner.
