(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Melville C. Westervelt, as Trustee:

All that piece, parcel, lot or tract of land lying situate and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as lot No. 16, Block E, sub-division of Augusta Court, according to plat recorded in Plat Book F, page 124, described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin Northeast intersection of a 30 foot street and Augusta Court and running thence with said 30 foot street N. 47-10 E. 152.5 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 16 and 21; thence with joint line of said lots N. 37-57 W. 61.1 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lots Nos. 15 and 16; thence with joint line of said lots S. 52-03 W. 154.1 feet to Augusta Court; thence with Augusta Court S. 39-33 E. 74 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same premises conveyed by Melville C. Westervelt, as Trustee to J. L. Bussey on or about January 8, 1923, deed for which was never recorded and has been lost.

This deed is made to correct the omission subsequently attempted to be added into deed of J. L. Bussey to Melville C. Westervelt, as Trustee, recorded in Book 225 at page 199.
