All my right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on Fall Creek waters of North Saluda River in Saluda Township, containing he acres more or less, and bounded on the North by E. S. Stanton lands (now belonging to C. L. Hill) and lands of Clint Shafer, on the East by E. S. Stanton lands, and the old Anderson Gordon tract, on the South by Anderson Gordon lands (now owned by Lewis Davis heirs), and on the west by Anderson Gordon lands, Being the land conved to R. B.
